

Southwest Side Road Projects Getting Underway

Hadley-Moon Road Roundabout--As the snow begins to melt, drivers can expect to see significant construction activity begin on this increasingly traveled corridor. Improvements are designed to extend from previous road projects in recent years, from near Sugar Grove on Moon Road to Glen Haven West on Hadley Road. The improvements will stretch south on Moon Road to the new Guilford Elementary School, including a new roundabout at the intersection of Hadley & Moon.



The roadway will be widened to include two full 12-foot lanes, with new turn lanes being installed at the school site. Improvements also include construction of an 8' pedestrian sidepath that will close an existing gap along the corridor, while also providing a new connection to the school. Street lighting and drainage improvements are also being incorporated into the project.

Utility work has been underway for months, but new road construction is expected to get started the first of March. Drivers can expect to see lane restrictions and flagging initially, but shortly after Easter, the project will be converted to accommodate one-way travel only. Vehicles will be allowed to continue west on Hadley Road, and will have the option of traveling either north or south on Moon Road. All other directions of travel will be required to detour around the site during that time.

During the Summer, a brief full closure will occur in order to make the necessary road tie-ins to the newly constructed roundabout. The roadway is expected to re-open to traffic in time for the 2021-2022 school year, though construction is expected to continue into the Fall.

The Town will provide additional and more detailed information as the project progresses that will help drivers be prepared for the travel restrictions that are necessary to complete the construction.

CR 675 East (Hall Road) Reconstruction--Back in 2017, the Town approved a request for annexation of property south of Hadley Road along CR 675 E. By agreeing to annex, the Town accepted jurisdiction over the adjacent roadway. Since that time, new housing has been getting constructed as part of the Bridlewood neighborhoods. This year, Hall Road

The project begins approximately 500 feet south of Hadley and stretches approximately 1/2 mile further south. Starting around mid-March, a full closure will go into effect. Detour signs will direct traffic to use CR 725 E as an alternative. Most of the local traffic will be required to access property from the south as the project includes a new culvert installation that will make the road impassable for several months.

This project was originally scheduled to occur in 2020 to avoid conflicts with the Hadley-Moon Road Roundabout, but COVID concerns delayed construction. Subject to accommodating weather, the project is being targeted to re-open ahead of the Hadley-Moon full intersection closure, though drivers should be prepared for restrictions occurring on both projects

through the first half of the construction season.

The Department of Public Works' Spring Heavy Trash Days will be held on April 17, and April 24, from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. Plainfield residents may bring acceptable heavy trash items to the designated dumpsters at the Town garage located at 986 S. Center Street. Items accepted include just about everything except hazardous waste, tires, building materials, or yard waste. This also includes furniture, although residents who bring mattresses will have to handle getting the mattresses out of their vehicle and into the dumpster on their own. For sanitary reasons, DPW staff will not handle such items. Residents should remove gas and oil from mowers and leaf blowers.
